










Amended NOTICE OF RACE 2019 TORNADO OPEN, MIXED AND YOUTH EUROPEAN CHAMPIONSHIPS



5th- 9th JUNE 2019

RIMINI-ADRIATIC SEA-ITALY

The Organizing Authority is the Italian Sailing Federation which delegates the Rimini Nautical Club together with the International Tornado Association International Tornado Association (ITA) and the Italian Tornado Class Association, under the authority of Italian Sailing Federation (*Federazione Italiana Vela - FIV)*], the World Sailing and the patronage Municipality of Rimini.

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the *Rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of World Saili* ng. (RRS). 2007/2020
- 1.2 The FIV Prescriptions will apply.
- 1.3 The ITA Class Rules "Appendix C International Events" and the "Equipment Inspection Regulations" will apply.
- 1.4 If there is a conflict between the Sailing Instructions and the Notice of Race, the Sailing Instructions shall prevail.
- 1.5 A boat chartered or loaned for the regatta may carry national letters or a sail number in contravention of the class rules (see RRS Appendix G.3).
- 1.6 In case of translation, if there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

2 ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Competitors may be required to carry advertising for event sponsors.
- 2.2 After the first day when races are completed, the first 3 boats in the provisional standings may be required to display a yellow, blue or red disc on the mainsail. Italian competitors displaying individual advertisements must be in possession of the FIV license for valid advertising and must present it upon completion of the registration. 3 ELIGIBILITY

- 3.1 All competitors shall meet the requirements of WS Regulation 19.
- 3.2 All competitors shall be members of the ITA and their current year membership fees shall have been fully paid and verified.

Italian competitors must be in possession of the FIV card valid for 2019, including health regulations.

Competitors under the age of 18 must submit the entry form signed at the bottom of the parent, guardian or support person that allows them to submit to the Rules (RRS 3.1 (b)) and who, during the event, assume the responsibility to do so descend into the water to race.

4 ENTRY

- 4.1 The regatta is open to suitable boats of the Tornado class. The suitable boats can enter by filling out the pre-registration directly on the website https://www.cnrimini.com or by downloading the form from the website and sending it by e-mail to cnrimini@cnrimini.com
- 4.2 The Participation Form and the completed participation fee of the appropriate vessel will be received by the Organization Body no later than 12th May.

5 ENTRY FEE

- 5.1 The Entry Fee is 350,00 € if the payment received by 12th may; 400,00 € if payment is received after this the date.
- 5.2 Payment Method: transfer money bank order into the account of the CLUB NAUTICO RIMINI ASD here below specified:

 - Money transfer order have to specific helmsmen's name, nation code and sail number. The is required in addition to the submission of the Official Entry Form.
 - The Entry Fee includes an ITA Class Fee of 50 Euros.
 - The Entry Fee is non-refundable.

7 EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

- 7.1 Equipment Inspection shall be conducted in accordance with the Tornado Equipment Inspection Regulations, copies of which will be available on the event website and at the Race Office from3thJune.
- 7.2 Each boat shall present a valid measurement certificate at Equipment Inspection.

8 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available after 27 MAY online at www.cnrimini.com

9 VENUE

- 9.1 The Boat Park will be located at **Club Nautico Rimini Asd, Largo Boscovich, 12-47921 Rimini (RN- Italy).**
- 9.2 Racing areas will bein front of the Rimini Port. See "Annex 1"











10 COURSE

The Championship Course as shown in class rules Appendix C-Attachment 1 will be used.

11 PENALTY SYSTEM

- 11.1 Rules 44.1 and 44.2 will be changed so that only one turn, including one tack and one gybe, is required.
- 11.2 Racing rule 44.3 will not apply.
- 11.3 Decisions of the jury will be final as provided in rule 70.5.

12 SCORING

- 12.1 The Low Point System of RRS Appendix A will apply.
- 12.2 4 races must be completed to constitute a series.
- 12.3 When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's worst race score will be excluded from her series score.

13 SUPPORT BOATS

All Support Persons must be accredited by completing the registration form available from the Race Secretary stating:

- 1) the characteristics of your own assistance boat;
- 2) acceptance of the "rules for support staff and assistance boats" described in the Sailing Instructions;
- 3) the names of the accompanied competitors.

Accredited Support Persons will be subject to the technical and disciplinary directives of the CoR and of the Jury that, in case of infringement, will be able to act according to rule 64.4 of the RRS

14 RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

15 PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows:

- (a) Trophies will be awarded to helmsman and crew of the top 5 finishing boats.
- (b) Trophies will be awarded to the top 3 "Mixed" teams.
- (c) Trophies will be awarded to the top 3 "Youth" teams.











- (d) Trophies will be awarded to the top 3 classified "Classic Tornado" teams.
- (e) Special Prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the Organizing Authority to teams who attend the prize giving ceremony.

16 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

RRS 4 of the Racing Rules of Sailing states: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone."

Sailing is by its nature an unpredictable sport and therefore inherently involves an element of risk. By taking part in the event, each competitor and their responsible adult agrees and acknowledges that:

- a) They are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of themselves, their crew and their boat to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the event;
- b) They are responsible for the safety of themselves, their crew, their boat and their property whether afloat or ashore;
- c) They accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by their own actions or omissions;
- d) Their boat is in good order, equipped to sail in the event and they are fit to participate;
- e) The provision of a race management team, patrol boats and other officials and volunteers by the event organizer does not relieve them of their own responsibilities;
- f) The provision of patrol boat cover is limited to such assistance, particularly in extreme weather conditions, as can be practically provided in the circumstances:
- g) It is their responsibility to familiarize themselves with any risks specific to this venue or this event drawn to their attention in any rules and information produced for the event and to attend any safety briefing held for this event;

17 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall have current third-party liability insurance with, including coverage when racing at the venue of the championship, of not less than 1.500.000€ for incident (or equivalent). Proof of this insurance shall be available at all times.

For Italian crews the FIV Derive Plus card can replace the RCA insurance policy.

18 PHOTOGRAPHY CONSENT

By entering the Championship competitors accept that they may be photographed and/or videotaped participating in the race and/or using the regatta facilities and they consent to the taking of such images and to the use, re-use, publication and republication of such images in any media, in conjunction with the competitor's name or not, without competitor approval of such images or any use thereof.


