WEATHER CONDITIONS

The following is an analysis of weather in Thessaloniki for the months of July to September based on data gathered by The Aristotelian University of Thessaloniki. The source of the data, is located in the center of the town therefore the winds on the gulf are expected to be slightly stronger.

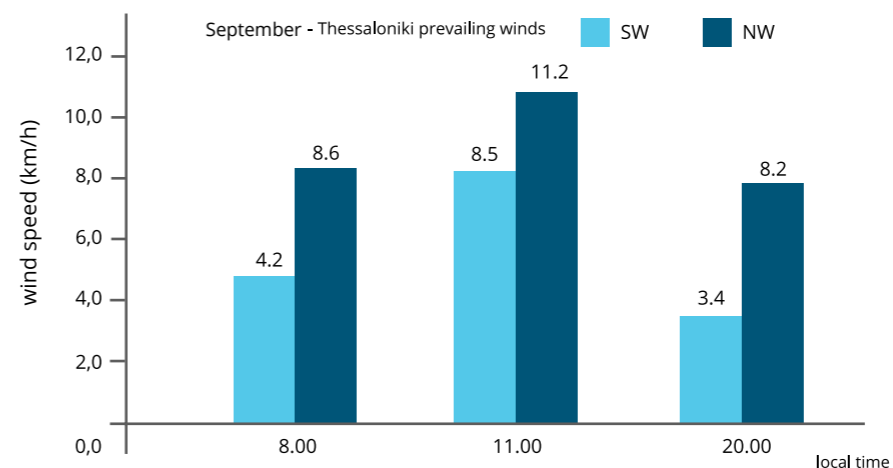
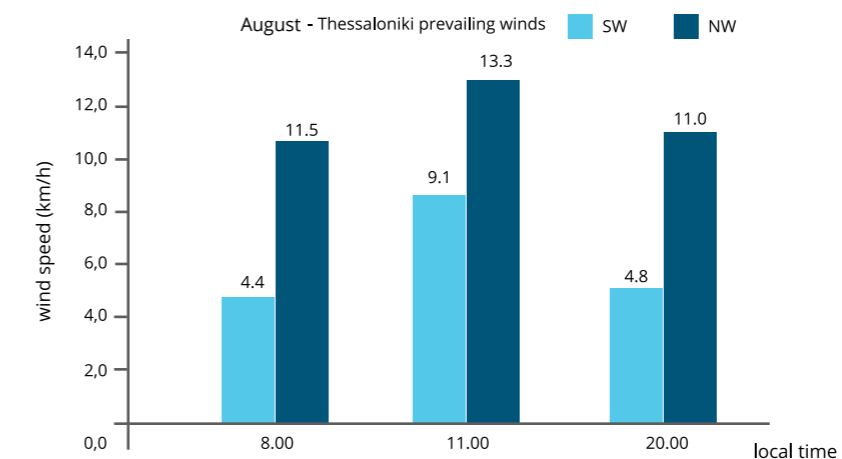
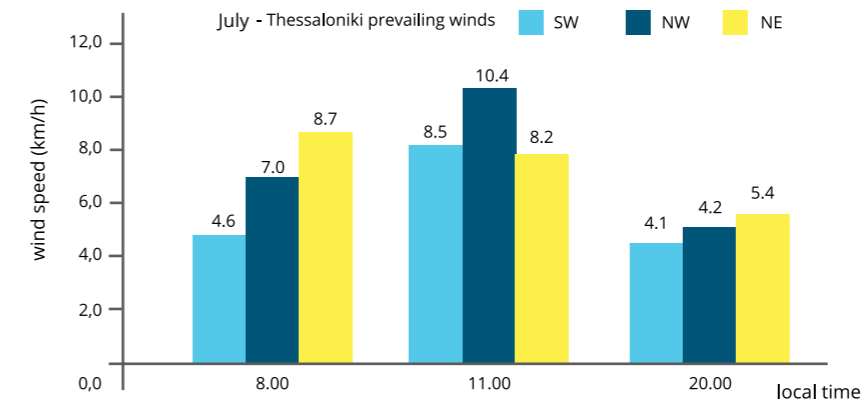
For all months the prevailing winds are (in order of frequency) SW, NW, NE and SE (primarily in the afternoon).

SW and NW winds are the most frequent (90%) at midday.

SW and NW wind force increases at midday (1400 hrs) and decreases significantly throughout the afternoon until about 2000 hrs.

The SW wind is the afternoon sea breeze of Thessaloniki locally known as the «boucadoura». This phenomenon is particularly strong during the month of July and takes place on a regular daily basis. Accordingly the month of August is the most suitable for sailing competitions.

In August the mean temperature is 28°C, ranging from 22°C to 35°C.
